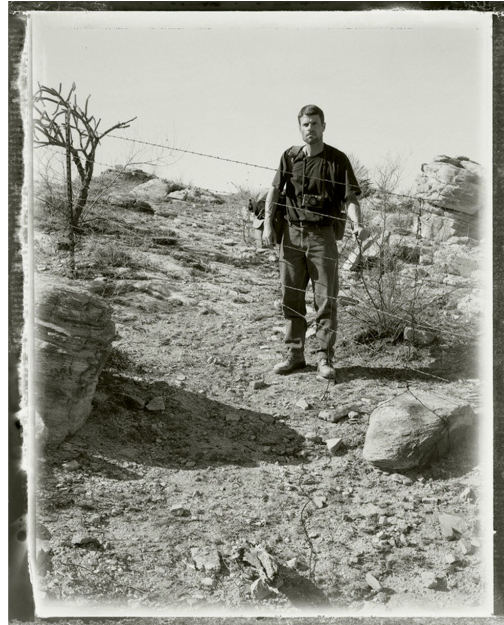


Paul Turounet |

Paul Turounet (b. 1962 in California) received his MFA in Photography from the Yale University School of Art in 1995. For the past 30 years, his practice has developed within the contexts of photography, writing, sculpture, site-specific and immersive gallery installations, and artist books, interweaving these various approaches in order to situate and intersect a personal connection to the contemporary social and cultural landscape.

The work explores an expansive range of subjects with a neutrality that hovers outside the social, cultural and political implications that it addresses, including how our personal and collective psychologies are confronted in the physical landscapes of history, culture and the environment.



Perspective is apt to shift, allowing for the discovery of something that may have initially seemed so clear and definitive to a critical space that may be more subtle, ambiguous and open to a greater interpretation.

Exhibition and installation highlights have included El Paso Museum of Art, Texas, Museo de Arte de Ciudad Juárez, Mexico, Museum of Contemporary Art in Tucson, Arizona, Aperture Foundation in New York, Ivorypress in Madrid, Spain, Musée des Beaux-Arts, Le Locle, Switzerland, Moscow House of Photography, Moscow, Russia and Centro Cultural, Tijuana, Mexico.

His 2016 self-published book, *Estamos Buscando A*, was shortlisted and a runner-up for the 2016 Paris Photo – Aperture Foundation First PhotoBook Award, and was included on the New York Times – The Best Photo Books of 2016.

Photographs and artist books are included in such institutional collections as Museum of Photographic Arts in San Diego, California Museum of Photography, Scripps College – Denison Library, Stanford University, Gunst Special Collection and Bowes Art & Architecture Library Collection, University of California at Berkeley – Bancroft Library Pictorial Collections, University of Southern California, Yale University Art Gallery and Yale University – Beinecke Rare Book & Manuscript Library.
